



Title: Tree Care Technician

Reports to: Tree Care Supervisor

Status: Regular, Full Time, Non-Exempt

Job Description: This position is responsible for assisting the Tree Care Supervisor in daily operations including commercial and residential property tree care maintenance, quality control, and safety.

Responsibilities:

1. Daily preparation of trucks, equipment, and inventory: report on time, load all equipment/materials for the days work, check all equipment is in working order.
2. Follow instruction from supervisor to accurately perform and manage tree care tasks on client's property including all aspects of tree removal, pruning, inspecting, climbing. Properly use safety equipment.
3. Perform end of the day duties including accurately recording hours worked, completing all job site reports and inventory all materials used on the job, review and prepare for the next day's job, unload/load equipment & material, clean out truck/trailer by removing trash, debris, etc.
4. Strictly adhere to Tree Trust's safety policies and procedures.
5. Assist LS Construction and Lawn Maintenance department, as needed.
6. Other duties as assigned.

Hours and Benefits: This is a fulltime, day position but must be available for flexibility in the work schedule based on the project needs. There is a possibility for travel away from main office for multiple days or overnight.
